Dress Code

Our dress code will be strictly enforced:

- No Bookbags
- Shirts/Blouses: White, Light, Dark Blue or Black. Must have a collar short or long sleeve (Cannot have insignias/brand names of any kind)
- Sweaters: Solid Colored White, Light, Dark Blue or Black (No Hoods/Hoodies of any kind)
- Bottoms: Dark Blue, Black or Khaki slacks, skirts, skorts, jumpers. Skirts, skorts and jumpers must be knee length. <u>Uniform shorts has to be knee length and not tight fitting may only be worn during the months of April through September only</u> (NO COLORED DENIM, No Yoga Pants or Jeggings)
- Socks/Tights: White, Dark Blue, Black
- Shoes: Dress Brown/Black, Athletic Shoes White/Black (NO Heels, Sandals, Flip Flops, Crocs, or Slides are not permitted)
- No Sagging: Brown or Black Belts Must be worn around the waist.
- No see through clothing of any kind.
- Tattoos Must be covered.
