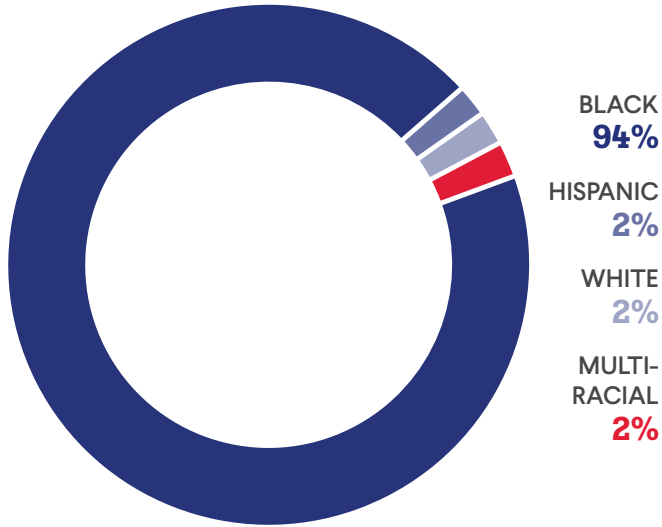

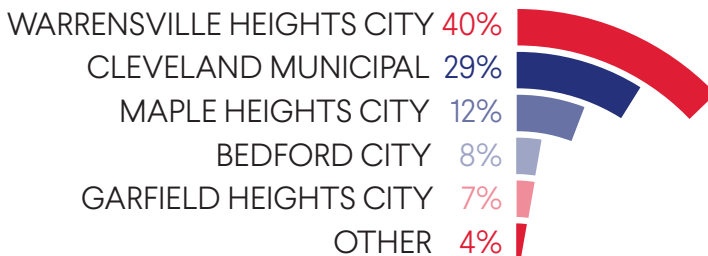

DISTRICTS OF RESIDENCE

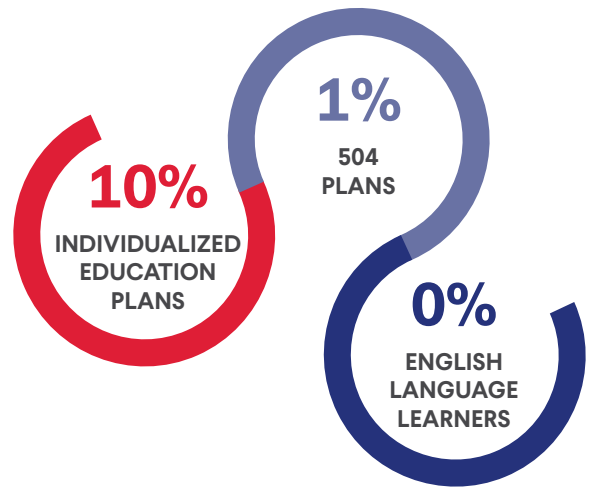

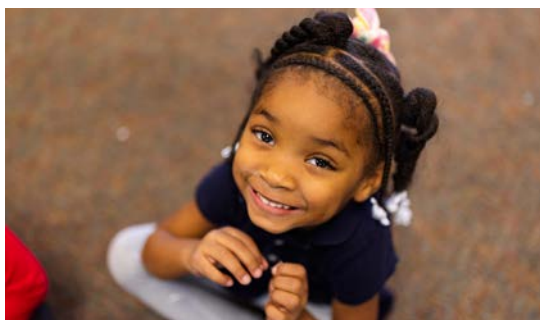

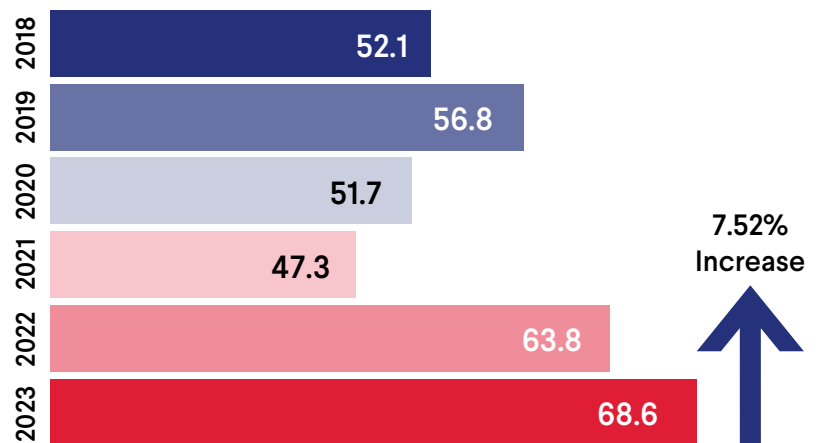

ACADEMIC PROGRESS

Following a year of strong academic recovery, in 2022-23 STEAM Academy increased the pace of student academic growth. The school increased its Performance Index score by over 7% and achieved the highest star rating in student academic progress (5 Stars, Progress).
